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1.2: Introduction

Thank you for purchasing **XimTouch Controller**, which is a card access system to control a single door. It may be used to restrict access to a room or any other sensitive area. The XimTouch Controller accepts door PIN from LCD keypad or proximity card reader technology.

Besides, it can be connected locally or remotely to a computer, in order to communicate with **XimTouch Access Control System**. The access control system is a powerful and user-friendly Windows-based application software that can support up to 64 door controllers. The application software also provides time and attendance management solution.



Chapter 2: Installation Procedures


Beginning the installation process:

- 1. Mount power supply unit on the wall.
- 2. Make sure the +12Vdc output switch is turned OFF.
- 3. Install power cord with all 3 wires connected as below:
 - EARTH: Green-Yellow
 - NEUTRAL: Blue
 - LIVE: Brown
- 4. Mount controller and proximity reader near to the door.
- 5. Mount EM lock on the door frame. Make sure to connect a diode across the coil for noise and spike suppression.
- 6. Install bypass keyswitch and emergency glassbreak for the EM lock.
- 7. Install magnetic door sensor and push button.
- 8. Connect controller to computer with a converter.
- 9. Connect all wires accordingly as shown in XimTouch Controller Wiring Diagram.
- 10. Apply power to the power supply unit. Turn ON +12Vdc output switch. The red LED of power supply unit will turn ON.

Chapter 3: Getting Started

3.1: Cold Start Operation

It is advice to perform a cold start after wiring is done, in order to clear all user databases and reset to default factory settings.

Steps:

- 1. Turn off power supplied to the door access controller.
- 2. Press and hold [*] + [#] while turning on the power.
- 3. Release the buttons until LCD shows cold start message.


Press [Menu] button followed by flashing card.


Press [Menu] button followed by the 6-digit Master PIN in order to enter the setting menu:

Chapter 4: Setting Main Menu



4.1: System Parameter



01-Master PIN

• Key in 6-digit Master PIN for setting menu entry.

02-Site Code

- Key in 4-digit Site Code.
- For example, a proximity card is printed with 123,45678:

Site Code: 0123 Card No: 045678

- To grant access, controller validates the site code and the card number.
- Site code is used to prevent access of other card with same card number.
- Support up to 3 Site Codes.

03-Clear Database

• To clear all user databases and reset all settings back to default.

04-Date & Time

- Key in current date and time in YY-MM-DD-hh-mm format.
- For example, 0908071153 for 09 (Year), 08 (Month), 07 (Day), 11 (Hour), 53 (Minute)

05-Terminal ID

- Key in 2-digit Terminal ID (00-15).
- Support up to 4 data lines, each data line with 16 controllers connection.

06-Swap Reader


- Press '0' to turn OFF or '1' to turn ON.
- Turn ON the swap reader when a controller and a proximity reader are installed. The controller will be assigned as EXIT reader and the proximity reader will be assigned as ENTRY reader.

07-Tamper Switch

• If the tamper switch is ON, the buzzer will generate beep sound whenever the controller is open up.

08-Buzzer Sound

• If the buzzer sound is OFF, the buzzer will be muted.



01-Lock Rel Time

The controller will release the door lock according to the lock release time (00-99 sec) if there is a
valid entry.

02-Dr Open Time

• If the door is open more than the door open time (00-99 sec), then the buzzer will generate beep sound.

03-Door Security

- Press '0' to turn OFF or '1' to turn ON.
- The controller will release the door lock if the door security is OFF.

04-Card+PIN Tz

- Key in 2-digit Time Zone number for Card + PIN.
- During this Time Zone, the user is required to flash the card followed by PIN number in order to open the door.

05-AntiPass Tz

- Key in 2-digit Time Zone number for Anti-Passback.
- During this Time Zone, the controller will prevent card user from entering the same area twice.
- To use anti-passback, an entry reader (proximity reader) and an exit reader (controller) are required to install.
- The main purpose of an anti-passback is to prevent a card user from passing his card back to a second person to gain entry into the same door.
- Besides, if a user follows a colleague OUT of the building without presenting his own card, he will not be able to return through IN door.

06-Lock Rel Tz

- Key in 2-digit Time Zone number for Auto Lock Release.
- During this Time Zone, the controller will release the door lock (Door security is OFF).


07-Door PIN

- Key in 6-digit door PIN number for door open with PIN entry.
- Support up to 10 door PIN numbers.

08-Clr AntiPass

• To clear all anti-passback violations.

4.3: Card Database



01-Install Card

- 1-Enter Card No or Flash Card: Enter 6-digit card number or flash card.
- 2-Card Expiry: Enter expiry date for the card in DD-MM-YY format.
- 3-Access Time Zn: Enter 2-digit access Time Zone number for the card.
- 4-Card PIN: Enter 4-digit PIN number for the card.


02-Delete Card

• Enter 6-digit card number or flash card for delete.

03-Clr Card DB

• To clear all user databases.

4.4: Time Database



01-Time Set No

- Key in 2-digit Time Set number (00-23).
- Each Time Set supports 3 time intervals (Interval 1-3).
- I1: S:hhmm E:hhmm: Key in time interval 1 in hh-mm format.
- I2: S:hhmm E:hhmm: Key in time interval 2 in hh-mm format.
- 13: S:hhmm E:hhmm: Key in time interval 3 in hh-mm format.


02-Time Zone No

- Key in 2-digit Time Zone number (00-23).
- Sun Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Sunday.
- Mon Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Monday.
- Tue Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Tuesday.
- Wed Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Wednesday.
- Thu Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Thursday.
- Fri Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Friday.
- Sat Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Saturday.
- Hol Time Set No: Key in 2-digit Time Set number for Holiday.

03-Holiday No

- Key in 2-digit holiday number (01-60).
- Hol Date [DDMM]: Key in holiday date in DD-MM format.
